Should we remove from this place, we shall unite as soon as possible with another church, where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word.

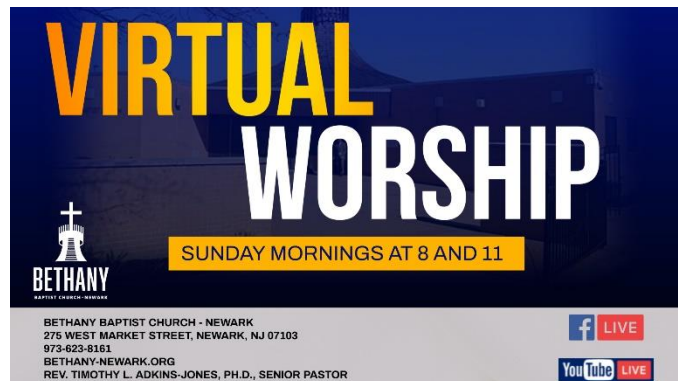
SUMMER WORSHIP SERVICE – The Bethany family will worship together in ONE SERVICE at 10:00 a.m. Sunday, June 12th.
